

7th/8th Grade SUPPLY LIST 2023-2024

- **6 spiral notebooks** (lined) for these 6 classes: Science, Spanish, Math, Social Studies, Literature, Language Arts
- **6 folders or 6 spots in an accordion folder** (*Plastic folders hold up better than the paper ones. You might want a binder to keep the folders together*) for Science, Spanish, Math, Social Studies, Literature, Language Arts
- **Pencils** (one pack)
- **Pens** (dark blue/black)
- **Eraser** (at least one large white or pink eraser)
- **Pencil case**
- **Free reading book** (**bring to class on the first day**)
- **Small sticky notes** (5 pack. 1.5" or 2") for annotating novels.
- **Highlighter(s)** (I suggest having at least three different shades)
- **100 Note Cards/Index Cards** —lined on one side (for research notes and flashcards)
- **A colored pen for correcting papers** (at least one colored pen other than black/blue for grading papers: red, dark purple, dark pink, or dark green)
- **Lined paper** (college rule)
- **Calculator** (for Math)
- **2 book covers** (for Math and Social Studies)
- **Access to a computer or laptop** on a regular basis (dedicated only to you) at home for writing papers etc., If you do not have access to this, please let me know.

Additional Suggested items that students always wish they have:

- Additional Erasers
- Colored Pencil set (other than Crayola, since we have those in class, but the quality and the color choices are very limiting)
- Fine-tipped Colored Pens set (ie., Gel pens and fine-tip felt pens)
- Artist pens in various colors for making posters and illustrations
- Mini Sticky tabs (to mark places in books where you have annotated or found information)
- Book Mark
- Graph Paper
- Whiteout
