

SUPPLIES,

Mr. Young's Seventh/Eighth Grades

Four single-subject notebooks, preferably college-ruled. For math, social studies, Maestra Lourdes' Spanish class and Ms. Rose's science class. If your writing dictates larger lines, that's fine. Your math notebook should be graph paper. Loose-leaf binders are discouraged as they take up so much table space. *NOTE*: you will also need a folder/binder for science handouts.

Pens are *required* for social studies. Any dark color will do, as long as it doesn't bleed through the page.

Pencils are *required* for math - erasable ink is NOT acceptable. Either wooden or mechanical is fine. An **eraser** is not a bad idea, either.

Graph paper will be needed for daily math assignments.

Two book covers. Math/Social Studies text books must be covered; paper bags make perfectly good, long lasting book covers. I have lots if you need one.

Calculator. A simple, basic calculator will do for most tasks. More sophisticated scientific calculators are useful at times, but if you are prone to losing your calculator, replacing scientific ones can get expensive. (Graphing calculators are also fine, but will not be necessary until high school.) Please put your name on your calculator in large letters.

USB memory stick. This way you won't have to email assignments between home and school, which is discouraged. Feel free to use *The Cloud* / *Google* instead, but it's not nearly as reliable.

Water bottle. Optional, but very useful.
